The ideal candidate shall possess the following qualifications:

Knowledge of law enforcement principles acquired through a 2 year diploma in a related field (Police Foundations, Law and Security) plus two years related experience.

Preference will be given to those candidates who hold a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer Certification and or Property Standards Officer Certification.

Successful applicants must achieve such certifications within 4 years of employment.

Candidates must have proven supervisory experience and have a thorough knowledge of computer applications including Microsoft Office Software. Candidates must also possess a valid Class G driver's license. The successful applicant will be required to provide a clear criminal records check and clear driving abstract.
